Club Championship Entry Conditions

1. All Galas will be held under the current ASA Laws and Technical Rules.
2. Events will be Heat Declared Winners (determined on times) except for 10 years and under events where there will be a final for 6 fastest heat swimmers.
3. Over the top starts may be used at the discretion of the Promoter.
4. Entrants must have been a member of Cheltenham Swimming & Water Polo Club (CSWPC), for at least 60 days prior to the Entry Date. Entry Cards will be used for all Galas.
5. Closing Date for entries is overleaf. Entry in OPEN Long distance events will be at the discretion of a Senior Club Coach.
6. Entrants who have not been a member of CSWPC for 60 days, or Entrants who wish to enter further events previously not entered, may do so up to 3 weeks prior to the actual event providing a Senior Club Coach has approved. A fee of £2.00 will be payable for each event entered. Entrants will swim as a guest in Heat 1 and will not be eligible for any awards or points towards any Club Trophies.
7. Awards/Trophies will be presented to the top 6 swimmers in the 10 years and under events and the top 3 in the 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 and Open Age Groups. **Age as at 31st December in year of Competition.**
8. One point will be awarded for successfully completing an event. In addition, Championship points will be awarded for 1st place = 10 pts; 2nd = 8; 3rd = 6; 4th = 4; 5th = 2; 6th = 1. On completion of all events the following trophies will be awarded:
 - Arthur Waite Cup** - Mens Championship - to the swimmer attaining the highest points scored from Open events
 - Harry Cater Trophy** - Ladies Championship - to the swimmer attaining the highest points scored from Open events
 - Margaret Macintosh Memorial Trophy** - awarded to the highest scoring 14 year old girl in the championship
 - Betty Howell Memorial Trophy** - awarded to the 10 year & under swimmer achieving the highest points scored from the 10 year & under events (to include the 100m IM)
9. All Cups/Trophies won in previous years must be returned to your coach by **30th October** the following year in order for them to be engraved prior to Presentation Night. All cups/Trophies will remain property of CSWPC and must be returned immediately on cessation of membership to the Club. Trophies will not be presented to swimmers who have left the Club prior to Presentation Night but their names will be engraved on the Trophy.
10. Entry Form must be correctly submitted and received by the Club before the appropriate Closing Date. ENTRANTS WHO DO NOT ENTER TIMES FOR ANY EVENT WILL SWIM IN THE EVENT'S FIRST HEAT WITH NO ENTRY TIME.
11. The Swimming Technical Committee, whose decision is final, will rule on any point not covered by the above conditions.
